

A Midsummer Night's Dream



A) The plot

As is the case with many plays, the plot of *A Midsummer Night's Dream* contains different stories (or *sub-plots*) which happen simultaneously but gradually come together. Here are the three main sub-plots at the beginning of the play.

- g) Egeus goes to Theseus, the Duke of Athens, who enforces an old Athenian law. Hermia can choose to marry her father's choice, Demetrius, live for the rest of her life in a nunnery (a convent) or die. Hermia chooses to escape with Lysander into the forest,
- h) Puck casts a spell on Bottom, one of the actors, to give him a donkey's head.
